1. Painting (Homowo festival)
2. Sculpture pieces (bust of the Chief)
3. Pottery (earthenware bowl)
4. Graphic Arts (Inscriptions on buildings)
5. textiles (traditional cloths worn)
6. basketry (cane /raffia chairs)
7. jewellery (necklace, beads)
8. leatherworks (scandals, shoes).
